The 98 and 99 buses serve Bexhill and the surrounding areas.

The 98 bus travels from Hastings to Bexhill, Sidley, Hailsham, Polegate and Eastbourne. This is currently not a low floor bus route.

The 99 bus route is wheelchair accessible, and it travels from Eastbourne to Bexhill, Hastings and Dover.

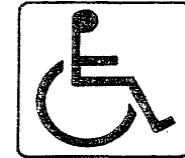

Bexhill Town Centre

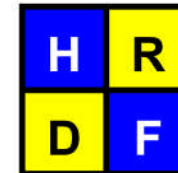
