1. What is the frequency of your general kerbside household waste collection i.e. weekly, fortnightly, monthly?

Rother DC provide both weekly & fortnightly waste collections dependant on the area and capacity of storage. The majority are fortnightly (37,500 properties) with (7,000) weekly collections mainly in town centre locations or communal.

- b. What is the frequency of collection for this provision? (if different for each waste type please state).

Rother DC provide fortnightly recycling waste collections.

- c. Is the recycling provision source segregated (i.e. numerous receptacles) or a mixed collection (i.e. all placed in one receptacle)?

Currently glass is collected in a separate receptacle with all other recycling items comingled in a 240 Litre wheelie bin, but this will change in June 2019 when all recycling items will be placed in a 240 Litre wheelie bin .

3. Does your authority provide a food waste kerbside collection service? If so what is the collection frequency?

Rother DC does not provide a separate food waste collection.

4. Does your authority provide a garden waste kerbside collection service? If so what is the collection frequency?

Rother DC offers an annual subscription based Garden Waste collection service to those customers who wish to pay a small subscription charge. Other than during the Christmas period (2 week suspension), collections are fortnightly. The charge is £35 per container (up to 3 max)

5. Do you provide a bulky item collection service? If so is there a charge and what is the charge?

Rother DC does provide a bulky item collection service at a cost of £36 for up to 3 items; £70 for 4 to 6 items, £103 for 7 to 9 items.

6. How many household waste recycling centres does your authority have?
