

Rother District Council:

Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning Document

ADOPTION STATEMENT

Rother District Council adopted the Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 16th October 2006.

Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application to the High Court must be made promptly and, in any event, not later than 3 months after the adoption date.

The Affordable Housing SPD elaborates on the application of Policies HG1 and HG2 of the Rother District Local Plan. It explains the process for providing affordable housing as part of new developments and on 'exceptions' sites.
